Partnerships & Strategic Relationships

- Champion safeguarding and best practise.
- Advocate that all Active Suffolk work and the work of partners, embeds safeguarding at all times.
- Signpost to practical guidance, information and training (where required).
- Work with Child Protection in Sport Unit and the Ann Craft Trust to design and deliver annual implementation plans.

Activities promoted or supported by Active Suffolk

(Groups, clubs & coaches etc)

- Signpost to practical guidance, information and training.
- Facilitate access to information about local statutory safeguarding arrangements and support.
- Advocate for physical activity and sport with local agencies.

Funded/ Commissioned Activity

(Delivered by third parties - e.g. Together Fund)

- Provide, clarify & ensure that our Minimum Operating Standards (MOS) are agreed to.
- Promote NGB safeguarding support and requirements (where relevant).
- Signpost to practical guidance, information and training.
- Monitor implementation of MOS and review safeguarding documents where required .

Direct Delivery by Active Suffolk

(e.g. School Games)

- Safeguarding Risk Assessment.
- Communicating and implementing safeguarding arrangements.
- Awareness of the Active Suffolk Safeguarding Policy and how to follow the procedures within it.
